



Patterns for a Cut and Create Zoo



PANDA



Cut a #1 circle from white paper.



Cut two #2 circles from black construction paper and glue them as shown onto the white circle.



Cut two #3 circles from black paper, two #4 circles from white paper, and two #5 circles from black paper. Glue them into a concentric pattern as shown.



Cut one #6 circle from white paper and glue as shown.




Fout one #7 triangle from black paper and glue it on the top, center of the panda's muzzle.



Use a black crayon or marker to add an upper lip and a smile to the panda.


TIGER



Cut one #1 circle from orange paper and two #2 circles from white paper.
Glue the white circles as shown.



2 Cut two #3 circles from black paper and two #4 circles from orange paper. Glue as shown.



Cut two #5 circles from orange paper and two #6 circles from black paper.
Glue the black circles onto the orange circles.



Glue the ears to the underside of the tiger's face. Cut one #7 triangle from brown paper and glue it onto the face.



Cut out and glue the #8 triangle from black paper. Glue as shown. Create tiger stripes by either cutting and gluing the #9 patterns or using a black crayon or marker.



Use a black crayon or marker to add a smile and "freckles."
You can also make whiskers from broom straw or pipe cleaners.
