PROJECT #1 - ALPHABET EYES

MATERIALS:

All artists will need pencils, pencil crayons and drawing paper. The step-by-step instruction pages should be made available to the class. Students can also be given "draft" paper for practicing each eye and experimenting by mixing elements from one eye to another.

METHOD:

Post or hand out the step-by-step instruction pages showing how the eyes are drawn. A class discussion can then occur where students are asked, "What do you notice about the eyes?" List the responses, as these can later act as clues and reminders to the students. Demonstrate drawing each eye style. Students can follow your lead. A large poster- sized paper can be hung on the board for demonstrating upon. White boards are very nice for art demonstration purposes as they are white like drawing paper and the white board pens are varied in colour.


Once eye styles have been explored, students can create "Happy Face"-style images, being as creative as possible.


Start with the letter "a".

Add the pupil and eyelashes.




Start with the letters "d" and "b".

Add the pupils and eyelashes.




Start with the letter "n".


Add the eyelashes.




Start with the letter "o".

Add the pupils.






Add the pupils, some lashes, and close the curved line.
