INTRODUCTION

Concentrated practice on a specific language skill will enhance and reinforce a student's knowledge of that skill. This book provides a variety of activities that will lead to a good understanding of the use of over 90 common abbreviations. Abbreviations are widely used as functional words in all types of written communication. It is important that students learn the meanings, spellings, and appropriate use of these shortened forms of words or groups of words.

Practice pages include matching, using abbreviations in sentences, spelling, puzzles, and identifying words that can be abbreviated. Included are a pre/post test, answer key, and a separate list of state names and their abbreviations which can be used to create teacher-designed activities for additional practice.




