


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
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# **Turn Up The Heat!**

How do you think the Eskimos stay warm in their igloos?


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# **Does It Have A Chewy Center?**

- The outer layer of Earth is called the crust.
- The layer under the crust is the mantle.
- The center of Earth is the inner core.
- The **outer core** is the layer around the inner core.


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### Surf's Up!

Good surfers study waves. They know all about them before they go surfing. Now you will know, too.

- The very top of a wave is called the **crest**.
- The foamy part coming off the crest is called a whitecap.
- The part of the wave leading up to the crest is the **scend**. (sounds like "send")
- The curved part of the wave under the crest is the curl or pipeline.

Why do you think surfers study the waves before going surfing?


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#### **Feet First**

If you bump your big toe, you might say, "Ouch! I stubbed my toe!" But if you hurt another part of your foot, would you know what it is called?

- The part that connects the foot and leg is the ankle.
- The back part of your foot, under the ankle, is the heel.
- The lower part, behind your toes, is called the ball of your foot.
- The curved part of your sole is the arch.
- The top of your foot is the **instep**.
