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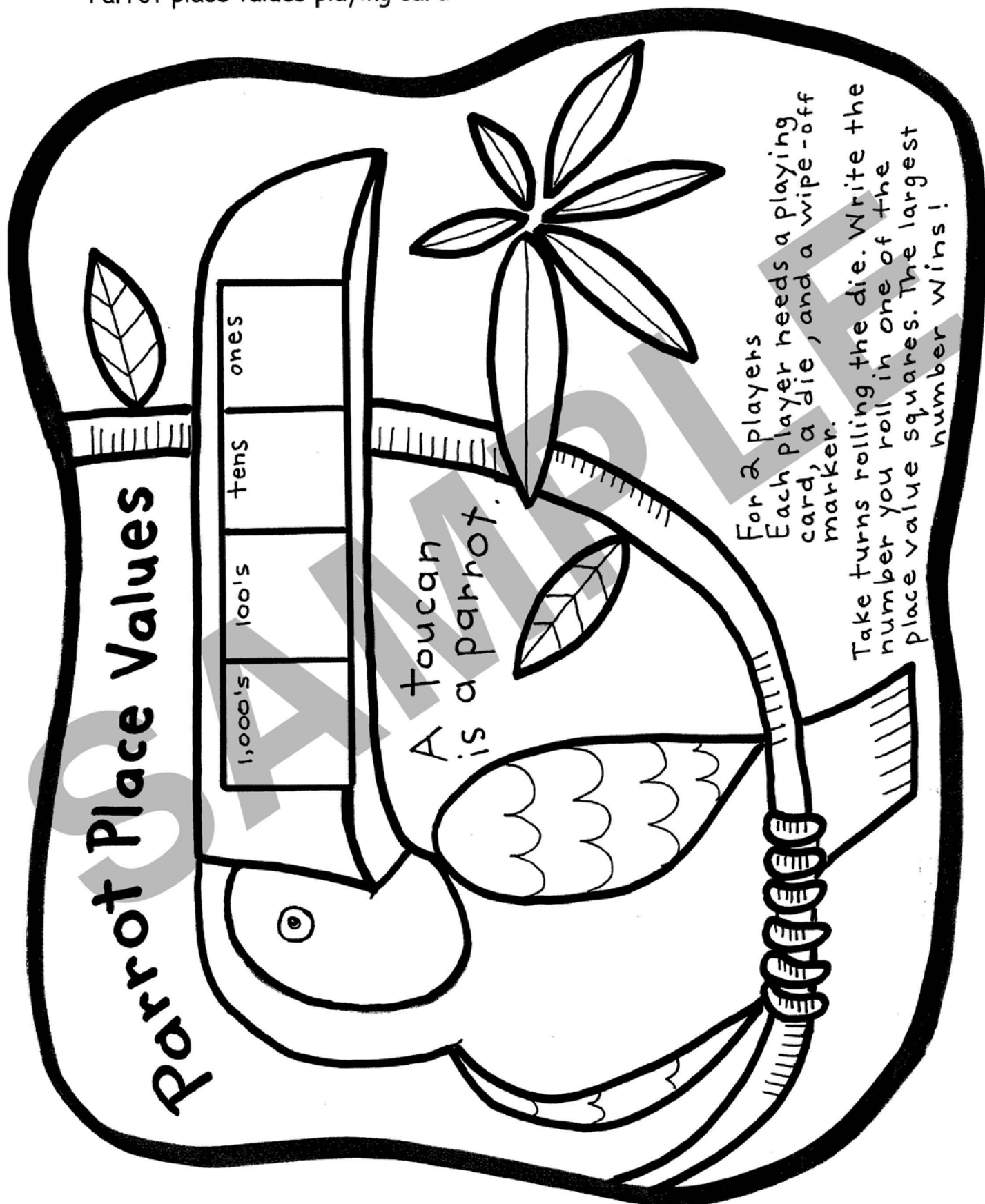
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Spots on a Jaguar - Sets to Numerals/ Math Equations

Using a black marker put spots on the jaguar faces. Fill in the number balloons with numbers to match sets to numbers.

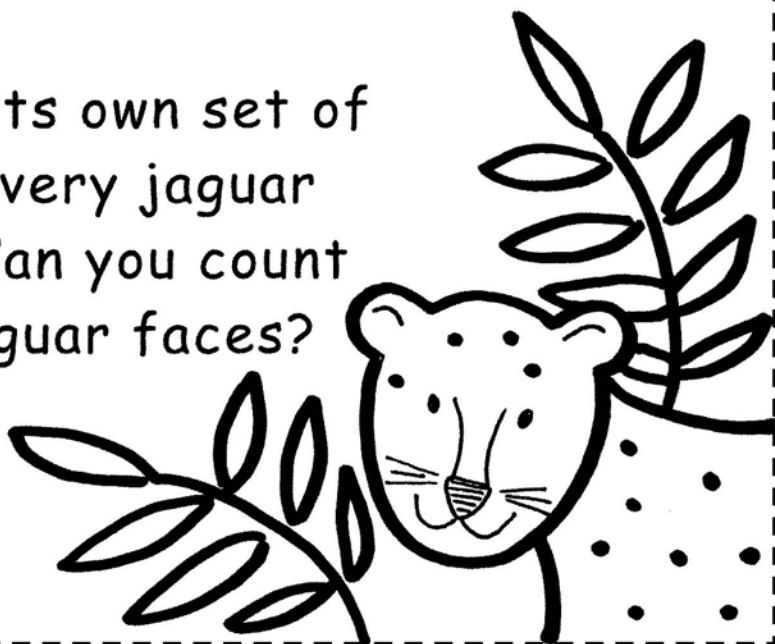
Optional
