

Count the numbers on the clock face by fives. Write the numbers in each box. The first one is done for you. Then answer the questions.




- 1. Where should the minute hand point to show 10 minutes?

The minute hand tells how many minutes past the hour it is.





The minute hand is pointing to the 2. This is 10 minutes.


