




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INTRODUCTION

The lessons in this book are based on essential vocabulary associated with weather conditions, weather instruments, and weather forecasting. Emphasis is on word definitions and word usage in context. Students become familiar with over 60 weather words while practicing basic skills in reading, comprehension, spelling, and writing.
