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# INTRODUCTION

Shopping at the mall is a popular activity for most students. Not only can students go there for clothing, but they can also go there for sports equipment, birthday cards, the latest video game, and more. The shopping mall is a great place for them to find most everything that they need under one roof. In order to do this, though, students need to understand what items can be found in which store.

**Shopping Mall Words** features 216 words of items that students may find in a mall. Activity pages emphasize word pronunciation, spelling, phonics, definitions, and identification. A pre/post-test is included to determine students' knowledge of shopping malls before and after completing the lessons. As students work their way through the book and its exercises, they will gain knowledge that will allow them to become more confident and independent when shopping at the mall. Students may find using a dictionary with some of the activities helpful.

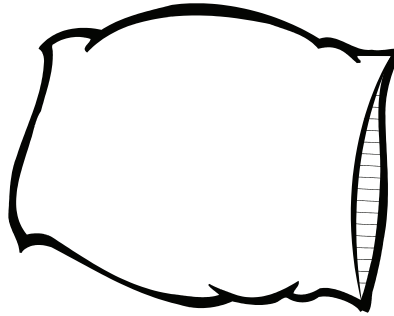
