Glue the instructions on another piece of bristle board. Laminate the game board and the instruction card.


Put the instruction card, the die, and 3 game markers in a zip close bag. Attach to the game board with a binder clip.


How to use

Place on a table for students to play. Introduce the game to the class. Read the instructions and talk about the coins used in the game.

More challenging options
