
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#### To The Teacher

Word lists in this book include many words commonly associated with a variety of sports and recreational activities. You are encouraged to add to these lists according to the needs of your students.

The following are suggested vocabulary activities which can increase the effectiveness of this book:

- 1. Brainstorm additional words for each list.
- 2. Use the words for spelling lists.
- 3. Use the research activity (page 48) to extend learning. A research topic list can be found in the front of the book.
- 4. Develop individual vocabulary booklets for words include dictionary pronunciation, part of speech, word origin, syllabication, etc.
- 5. Clip articles from sports section of newspapers or magazines look for sports words and terms.
- 6. Play sports charades act out a sport.
- 7. Write a review of a tournament or game.
- 8. Write an ad to sell a particular piece of sports equipment.
- 9. Write directions telling how to play a particular sport.
- 10. Make a list of sports objects tell who would use each object.
- 11. Discover words on the vocabulary lists that have meanings other than their "sports" definition. Discuss multiple meanings.
- 12. Use words in auditory activities:
  - a) Pick a sport tell how to play that sport.
  - b) Give a play-by-play description of a basketball, football, or baseball game (make-believe).
  - c) Be a coach give a pep talk.
  - d) Talk about a famous athlete's life.

#### Introduction

Each lesson (every 3rd page) contains a word list and is accompanied by two practice pages. You are encouraged to extend these lists and develop additional lists according to the needs of your students. Glossary of terms is included on pages 49-53.

The following are suggested vocabulary activities which can increase the effectiveness of this unit.

- 1. Have class brainstorm additional words for each list.
- 2. Use words for spelling lists.
- 3. Have students make their own vocabulary books of words. Include dictionary pronunciation, part of speech, word origin, etc. Make cover with a sport shape (baseball, tennis, soccer, etc.)
- 4. Have students play charades with words.
- 5. Have students put words on flash cards.
- 6. Have students use encyclopedia to discover origin of various sports.
- 7. Feature words on a bulletin board.
- 8. Have students write poems using words on list.
- 9. Have students write ads to sell something on a word list.


