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
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Introduction

• There are many ways to use the pages in this handy resource. The pages can be used in class or at home. Use them with a large group, a small group, or have children work on them independently.


Homework


Small Group

Use the reproducible as a small-group activity when you have centers. Display a completed reproducible for children who have trouble doing paper/pencil tasks on their own. They can refer to the completed reproducible for help.



Independent Work

Place a set of reproducibles in a basket. Invite children to work on one when they have finished their class work. Be sure to provide children with reproducibles that reinforce skills that have previously been taught in class.










